Horse Training

Due to the nature of our in-depth program, we do not take horses in training for less than sixty days. We intentionally keep our training horse numbers low and strive for a ten head limit with two riders.

Training fees includes good quality hay and/or pasture and salt/mineral block or free choice. All other expenses will be billed and include shoeing, vaccines, worming, vet care. All training prices include two hours of free individual lessons per month, additional lessons may be purchased at the rate listed below. Lessons are to be taken before horse in training is allowed to leave unless prior arrangements have been made. We encourage owners to come often to observe the progress of their horse. Observations are not charged for and are a good tool to enhance the investment you are making in your horse.

\$850 per month - No cattle work of any kind.

\$950 per month - Training on cattle; may include tracking & rating, basic ranch cutting maneuvers, roping (arena & ranch), alley & gate sorting, moving between pastures, and more.

\$950 per month- Travel Experience Training. For those wanting their horse seasoned to travel we will include them on our trips and use them in our clinics and ranch work such as brandings, and more. Rates are listed below for those who want show experience on their horse. Additional applicable charges for Travel Training will include stalls, cattle charge, facility charge, grooming, stall cleaning, etc., see rates below. Only four horses at a given time will be accepted into Travel Ex. Training.

Additional charges:

Board Only: \$250/month (Board included in training horse charge)
Supplement Feeding: \$3/day - must be pre-packaged
Blanketing 2x daily: \$5/day
Vet Care: \$15/day minimum (price dependant upon extent of care required)
Hauling: \$100 minimum (.70 per mile round trip after 100 mi.)

Horse Show charges:

Schooling: (non-schooling rates on a case by case basis)
\$75 - One day show
\$65 - per day/multi day show
Tack Room Stalls: Split up between all horses
Bedding: Split up between all horses
Grooming: \$60 day/includes clipping, bathing, daily show grooming, tack prep & cleaning, tacking & un-tacking, blanketing.
Day Fee: \$20 day/includes feeding and stall cleaning only on days not shown.
Travel Expenses: Split up between all horses; fuel & meals.
Motel or RV space: Split up between all horses.
Entry Fees, Stall Fee, & Cattle Charges: To be paid in full by the owner by show deadline date.

Groups over 6 riders constitute a clinic; see clinic rates below. All lessons not scheduled at ranch or not at a location we are already at will assess additional travel expenses at .65/mile. Most lessons are not on a strict hourly schedule, rather, the need of the moment dictates the lesson length. This is a general guideline.

Clinics

Fee includes both Mitch & JoLinn instructing with maximum individual rider time!

1 Day Clinic	6-14	\$150 per person	(\$1,500 minimum)
2 Day Clinic	6-14	\$275 per person	(\$3,000 minimum)
3 Day Clinic	6-14	\$375 per person	(\$4,000 minimum)

Auditing- \$30/day - 10% discount to youth and Senior's.

Additional rider charges will vary according to location but may include stalls, facility fee, meals, trailer parking, etc. Riders are responsible for their own horse care (feed, bedding, water containers, etc.). Clinic hosts receive extra benefits, see host package for more information.

Coaching

Additional charges include all travel expenses (fuel, flight, meals, motel) unless at an event we are already scheduled for (some coaching included for training customers and are on a case by case rate, see us for this service).

Shows & Other Competitions:

Exclusive

\$400/day Coaching days — includes all aspects of the event attending including pre-class preparation, walk-through strategies for trail or reining, mental preparation, and over all show prep.

\$250/day Travel days— days spent traveling to and from event attending.

Per Class (offered only at events we are already scheduled to attend).

\$30 - 45 minute max.; includes 5-10 minute pre-class, & 5-10 minute post-class conference and assessment.

Phone Coaching

\$55/hr. (\$30 minimum) - includes pre-show class assessment and recommendations, class strategies, rule analysis, attire, and more. Also includes training questions and prior preparation suggestions for your horse, and more.

Video Critique— \$55

Schedule a video viewing appointment for a location we are at or send us your show or training video and we will assess the strengths and weaknesses in your content. Fee includes written and/or verbal summarization with you to formulate a plan to help attain your goals.

Clinic Host Package

When hosting an MJ Rising H Ranch clinic there are some responsibilities and some benefits. We work closely with all our hosts to ensure a successful event for all!

Host Responsibilities:

Help select clinic date.

Procure a facility suitable for clinic type; take care of any necessary paperwork for that such as facility contracts and details of what insurance requirements we need to provide.

Determine additional rider fees (stall, parking, cattle, etc.).

Fill the clinic with riders.

Provide obstacles and/or cattle.

Distribute promotional material if needed; provide by MJ Rising H Ranch.

Handle rider application process and collect all deposits and balances.

Act as on-site organizer.

In addition to the required clinic fee the host will provide lodging for 2-4 horses, one meal per day per instructor, and make showers available for instructors. While we usually prefer to sleep in our own trailer, if the weather is extremely cold we will ask for inside lodging.

Host Benefits:

When the clinic has reached the required minimum the host is gifted a free rider spot. They may choose to utilize it themselves, or they may sell it and retain the monetary value themselves. For clinic hosts that go above and beyond the call of duty we often offer free lessons or coaching, rider spots at our other clinic locations.
